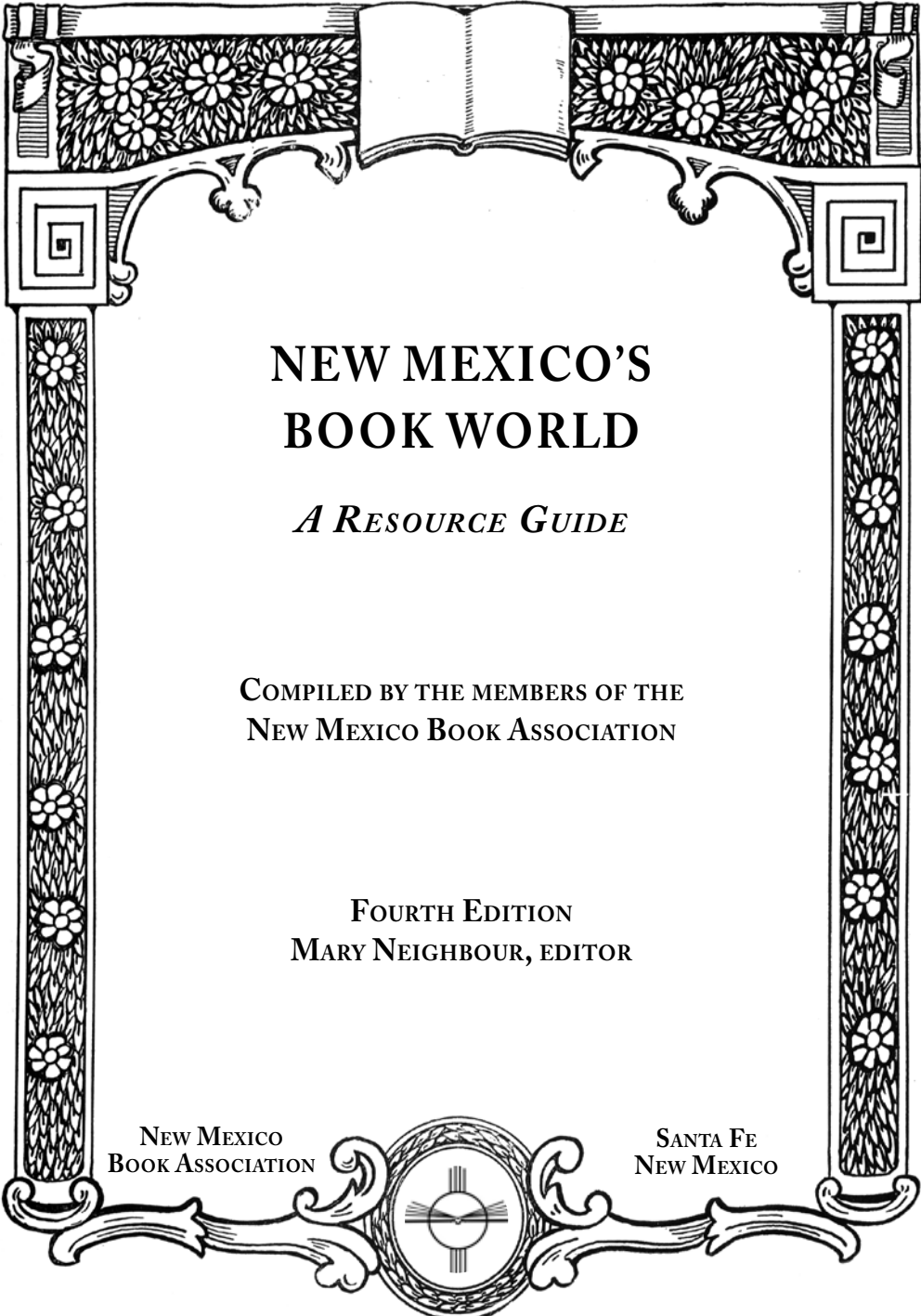

Introducing *Book World*



NEW MEXICO'S *BOOK WORLD*, now in its fourth edition, reflects the astonishingly rich literary history of the land of enchantment and brings today's talented contributors to this heritage. A place of writers, poets, printers, and readers for four centuries (Perez de Villagra's *Historia de la Nueva Mexico* appeared in 1610), our region continues to attract all who value excellence in the written word and the book: authors, researchers, publishers, editors, designers, booksellers, and publicists, to name a few. It seems most appropriate that this land of "literary enchantment" should produce the most comprehensive directory of its kind in the state.

Much has changed in the book and publishing scene, both in New Mexico and internationally, since the last edition of this resource guide appeared in 2006. New technologies have made it possible for authors' works to appear in print faster and easier than ever before. Smaller and single-title publishers proliferate. E-book technology rapidly has entered the field. And the Internet has opened new possibilities for book promotion and marketing that were not available only a few years ago. Nationwide, far more titles are produced every year than at any time in history.

Most large East Coast publishers have been absorbed by global conglomerates; bookstore chains are evaporating. Yet well-run bookstores and libraries across the land continue to prosper as inviting community centers serving the needs of readers. Access to books and periodicals—in print or electronically—remains available to all, regardless of economic class or circumstance.

The New Mexico Book Association joins with other groups in helping both book producers and readers find new ways to enhance the positive trends and confront the challenging ones. *New Mexico's Book World* is a helpful and vigorous part of that effort.

Introducing NMBA

NEW MEXICO BOOK ASSOCIATION brings together enthusiastic and dedicated people whose lives and livelihoods are entwined with producing books and providing them to the public. Shortly after its founding in 1994, NMBA became the pioneer among statewide book publishing groups in opening its membership to all individuals, businesses, and institutions professionally involved with books. Editors, writers, printers, libraries and librarians, booksellers, publishers, book designers, publicists, marketers, and others have a home in NMBA.

Our roots trace back to the days when New Mexico members of the Rocky Mountain Book Publishers Association (RMBPA, today's PubWest) met monthly to share news and network informally. As the publishing scene grew, those luncheons drew a larger group of people: independent editors, writers, illustrators, designers, and bookstore owners, among others.

Early in 1994, Mexico's renowned Guadalajara Book Fair chose the state of New Mexico as the featured "country" for that year's fair. It was quite an honor, but it became clear that, in order to be properly organized and funded, a nonprofit was needed to ensure success of New Mexico's presence at Guadalajara. Victor di Suvero and publisher Michael O'Shaughnessy approached people from the local luncheon group, and the New Mexico Book Association was conceived.

Meanwhile, Jim Mafchir, with help from New Mexico publishing enthusiasts, maintained regular RMBPA luncheon gatherings, which gave strong impetus to the founding of NMBA.

After the Guadalajara Fair, the networking luncheons became more popular than ever, and membership grew. NMBA's monthly *Libro* publication first appeared in April 1995, and we initiated a variety of programs to help support the aims and aspirations of our diverse members.

Over the last two decades, NMBA and its members have taken part in BookExpo America, the Border Book Festival, Santa Fe Festival of the

Book, New Mexico Library Association and American Library Association conferences, New Mexico Women Authors' Book Festival, PubWest's annual national publishing conference, and IBPA's (Independent Book Publishers Association) Publishing University. We produce the *New Mexico Showcase Catalog* annually for our members, sponsor many professional development workshops, host the Southwest Book Design and Production Awards competition, and support online book marketing initiatives.

Libro keeps members connected and informed, with news of book industry developments, information on member achievements, announcement of book signings and author appearances, and an extensive calendar of events. Our NMBA website, www.nmbook.org, informs people well beyond New Mexico's borders about activities in the lively book community here. Members are kept abreast of latest developments and opportunities through timely NMBA FlashNews email alerts.

Our Book in Hand Honor recognizes outstanding bookstores and individual booksellers for their initiatives in getting books into the hands of readers. Every month, luncheons and workshops keep members connected and informed of the latest opportunities in publishing. NMBA's Annual Gala Luncheon and Membership Meeting takes place in the summer. The NMBA Holiday Fiesta party in December draws people from throughout the literary and book community of New Mexico.

NMBA is a recognized 501(c)6 professional nonprofit, managed by an enthusiastic board of directors and a part-time Executive Administrator. Our office is currently at 1600 Lena Street, Bldg. C, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505.

Our only criterion for membership in NMBA is an interest in books, primarily in New Mexico. NMBA's membership year begins on January 1. 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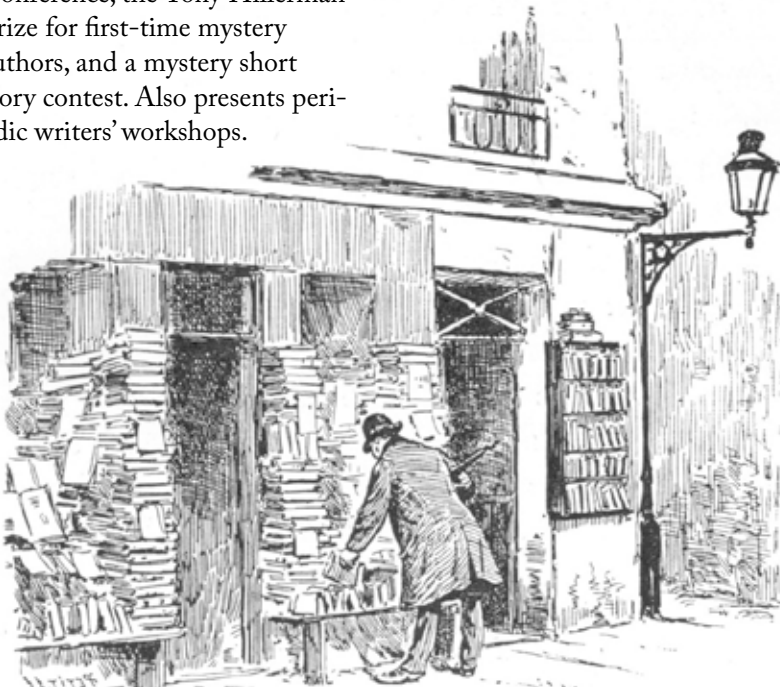


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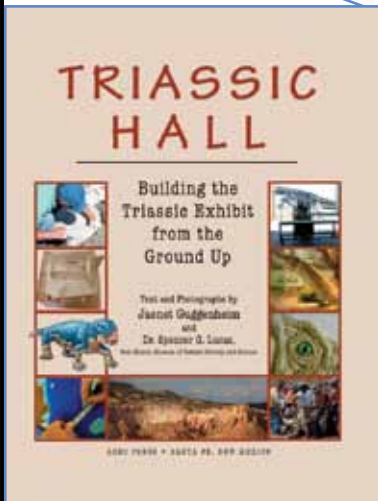
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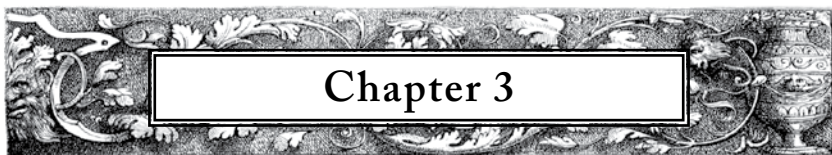
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Chapter 3

New Mexico Publishers

NEW MEXICO HAS A long publishing history, much of which is described in Pamela Smith's book, *Passions in Print: Private Press Artistry in New Mexico*, published by the Museum of New Mexico Press in 2006. In recent years, however, the business of publishing books has changed dramatically. For example, most of the New York publishing houses are now subsidiaries of large international media corporations. At the same time, smaller publishers in specific niches have blossomed and frequently are more accessible for writers. In another development, new technologies have made self-publishing an attainable, reputable option for thousands of writers.

Getting a book into print is easier and more economical than ever, but successful marketing is a daunting challenge. More titles than ever are being produced, yet they compete for the diminished reading time of the average consumer. Publishers' marketing budgets have shrunk for all but the most popular established writers. Authors must take the initiative to put themselves in front of the public and promote their own works.

In this section are New Mexico publishers, many of whom are members of the New Mexico Book Association (indicated by ➞). Our publisher members range from single-title firms to larger commercial and institutional presses.

If you are looking for an appropriate publisher for your work, seek out those who publish books of similar type and subject matter. Check their websites and communicate with an in-house editor to learn how they like to receive submissions (e.g., sample chapters or full manuscript, digital file or hard copy). They might appreciate your promotion and marketing suggestions. 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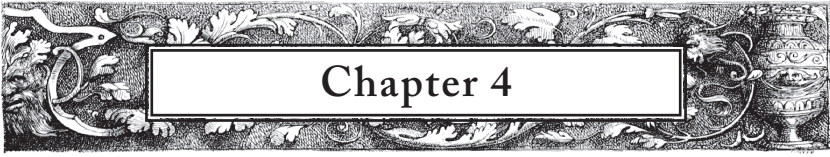
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Chapter 4

New Mexico Media & Review Publications



HIS SECTION IS DIVIDED into four categories. Each is organized alphabetically by city or town or by name:

1. Newspapers and magazines of New Mexico
2. Key television and radio stations in the state
3. A select shortlist of out-of-state media
4. National reviewing publications

Major dailies, such as the *Santa Fe New Mexican* and *Albuquerque Journal*, have sections and will review selected books from the region. *New Mexico Magazine*, *El Palacio*, and *Weekly Alibi* also regularly feature book reviews. Don't ignore small town newspapers—they are always hungry for short, well-written articles with a local or regional angle, and many prefer to “tie in” with an event, such as a reading, taking place locally.

What should you provide when you query a publication? Consult websites for specific submission guidelines. Generally, you will need a professionally written query letter and a descriptive press release or sell sheet that provides, among other things, ordering information and an image of the cover. For reviews, look to see if they want galley proofs or printed books.

Public television and radio stations often have opportunities for authors to talk about their books on the air. For all broadcast media, authors and publishers should offer to provide the program producer with a one-page sheet of questions that the interviewer might ask you. If they are unfamiliar with your subject, they will appreciate these suggestions.

National reviewing publications often need to be approached several months in advance of the announced publication date of the book. They may require more than one review copy. Again, check their websites to obtain complete, up-to-date submission guidelines, and be sure that your book is appropriate to the reviews they publish. ~ Cindy Bellinger and Michael Hice

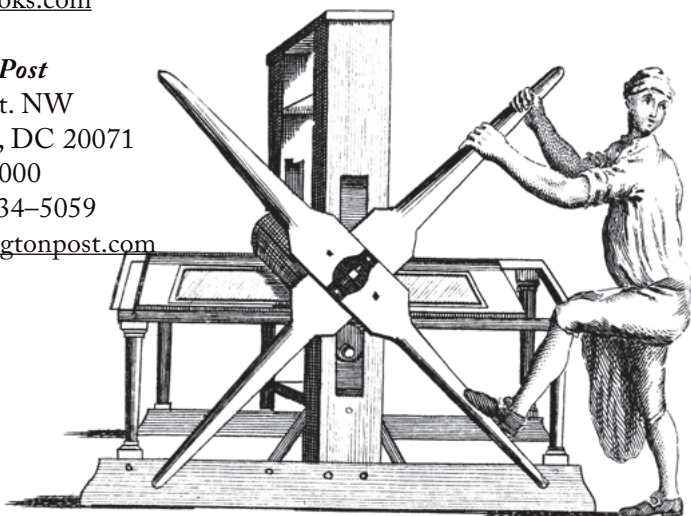

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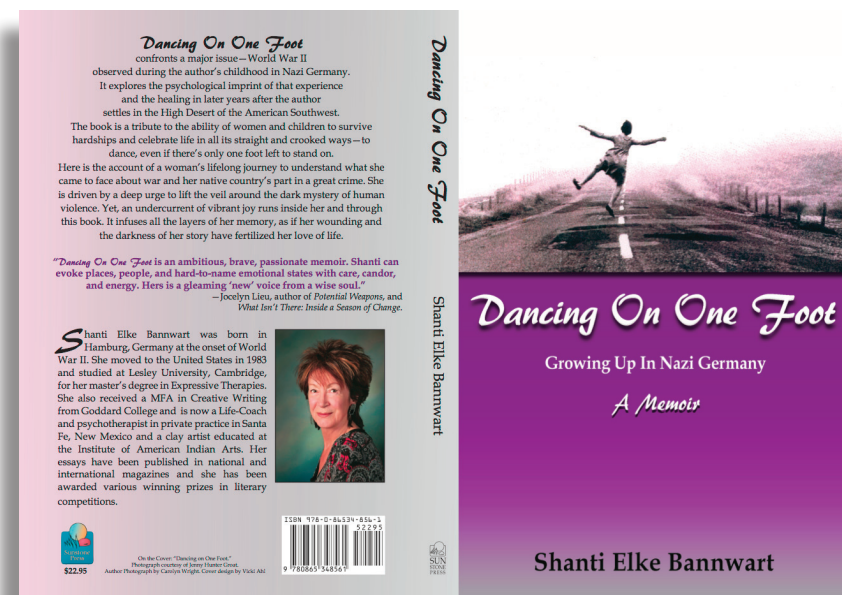
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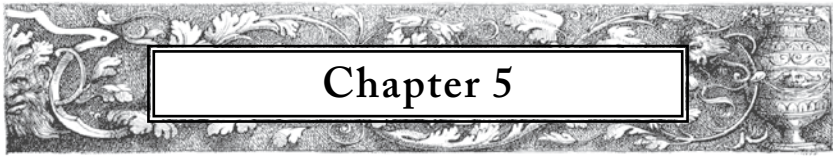
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Chapter 5

any authors earn their first publishing break by winning an award for excellence in writing or book design, since numerous contests offer publication and publicity in addition to cash prizes. Moreover, a shiny sticker on the cover of your book makes it stand out from others on store shelves, helps build a writer's platform, and tells potential agents and publishers to take notice. Most competitions have entry fees, and authors are urged to read eligibility rules carefully and observe submission guidelines. For additional insight into matching your writing to a particular competition, pay attention to the judges and past winners.

To help you get started, this chapter offers descriptions* of regional and some prominent national awards for fiction, nonfiction, poetry, and e-books. However, there are hundreds of opportunities—far too many to list—so we've included some useful Internet resources, including those that report on disreputable contests. Nearly all competitions are held annually.

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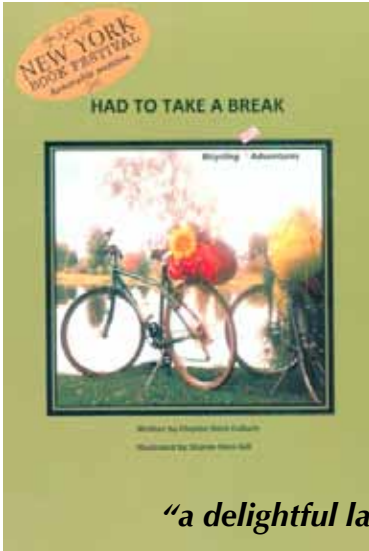
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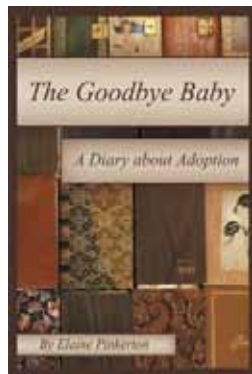
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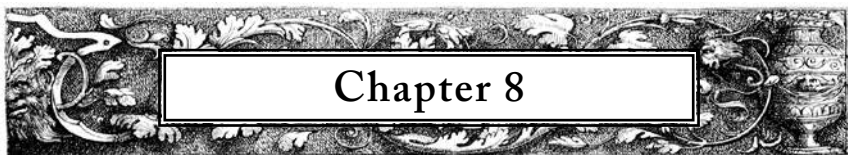
